THIS MATTER coming up on 11th June, 2026 for Directions on the Notice of Motion dated 11th June, 2026 ex parte.

UPON PERUSAL AND CONSIDERATION of the Certificate of Urgency as filed by the Counsel for the Claimant/Applicant, the aforementioned Notice of Motion, its Supporting Affidavit as sworn by one LYNDA AMBIYO, the annexures thereto and the salient grounds as set out therein:

AND UPON BEING SATISFIED that the matter discloses sufficient urgency and that the Applicant has demonstrated a prima facie case to warrant the grant of interim reliefs in the first instance;

1. THAT the matter is hereby certified as urgent.
2. THAT the Claimant/Applicant shall serve upon the Respondent all filed pleadings being the Notice of Motion and its accompanying documents, the Petition together with this Order by C.O.B. 12th June, 2026. The service shall be physical or via electronic means.
3. THAT the Respondent shall file and serve its responses to the Application and the Petition on or before noon 16th June, 2026, and the applicant shall have leave to file a further affidavit after such service, if need be. Whereas being cognizant of the exigency of the matter, the Parties may also make oral representations during the Mention.
4. THAT in the interim, to safeguard the substratum of the suit, a temporary injunction is hereby issued restraining the Respondent, the Football Kenya Federation, whether by itself, its National Executive Committee, its Leagues and Competitions Committee, its officers, servants, agents, or through any other person or body acting on its direction or behalf, from implementing or giving effect to the decision communicated vide letter Reference FKFGS/MISC/EXT/180 dated 6th June 2026 to the extent that the said decision purports to automatically relegate the Petitioner from the



FKF Premier League without the conduct of the mandatory end-of-season promotion/relegation play-off.

5. THAT, equally, a temporary injunction is hereby issued restraining the Respondent from finalising, announcing, or publishing the composition of the FKF Premier League for the 2026/2027 season in a manner that excludes the Petitioner and/or take any steps that assume, treat as conclusive, or give effect to the automatic relegation of the Petitioner from the FKF Premier League for the 2026/2027 season, including but not limited to issuing any communications to clubs, sponsors, or the media to that effect.

6. THAT the Panel constituted to hear this matter shall be:

- b. Hon. Peris Alela Mukoko
- c. Hon. Luke Wamugunda

7. THAT the Matter shall be mentioned on 17th June, 2026 at 2.30 p.m. via Microsoft Teams before the Tribunal to confirm compliance and for further directions.
